Chong Siah Leong (鍾协隆)

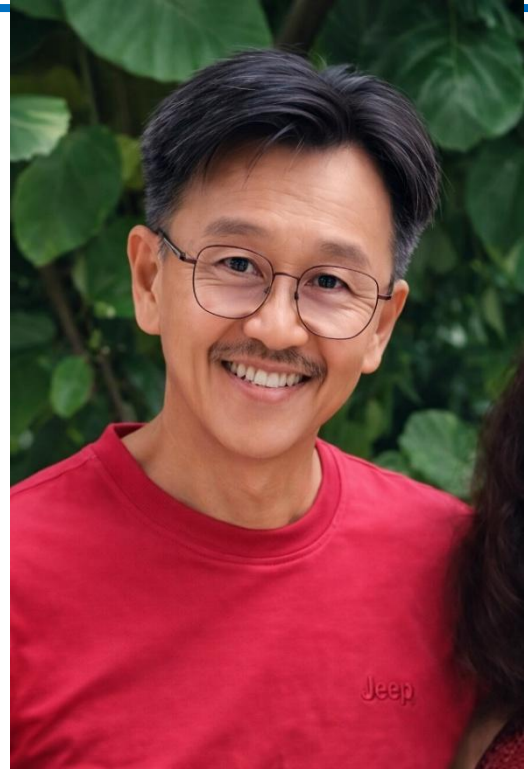

His expertise is further recognized through his position as a judge with MBJO (Malaysian Bonsai Judges Organization), where his discerning eye helps uphold the standards of the craft.

Chong's legacy is not only measured in awards but in influence. His dedication inspires younger generations, while his leadership strengthens the bonds of Malaysia's bonsai community. Each tree he shapes carries the quiet story of discipline and artistry, reflecting his belief that bonsai is more than horticulture — it is living sculpture, a dialogue between nature and human hands.
